Product Overview

Tide Plant Guard is a spray adjuvant containing a blend of methylated soybean oil and surfactants for applications with post-emergence herbicides.

Key Product Details

- **Product Type:** Spray adjuvant for tank mixing
- **Formulation:** Solution – Commercial
- **Active Ingredient:** Methylated seed oil of soybean – 50.00%
- **Allergen warning:** Contains the allergen soy

Best Practices for Use

- **SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING**
- **Add last** – always add Tide Plant Guard to the spray mix as the last ingredient, and continue agitation
- **Follow the herbicide label** for crop use, timing, and tank-filling instructions
- **Low spray volumes:** when using spray volumes below 93.54 L/ha, do not apply less than 469 mL/ha of Tide Plant Guard
- **Storage:** store dry, away from heat or open flame, above freezing; if frozen, warm and agitate (recirculate) before use

Application Rate

0.50% v/v – 5 L Tide Plant Guard per 1000 L spray mixture

- When applied in a tank mix, read and observe all label directions, rates, PPE, restrictions and precautions of each product used
- Always follow the most restrictive label

Restrictions

- ⊘ DO NOT apply by air.
- ⊘ Not registered for control of pests in aquatic systems – do not use to control aquatic pests.
- ⊘ Do not contaminate irrigation or drinking water supplies or aquatic habitats when cleaning equipment or disposing of wastes.

Safety

- KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN; read the label before using
- Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing
- PPE: long-sleeved shirt, long pants, chemical-resistant gloves, socks and shoes during mixing, loading, application, clean-up and repair
- Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling

Directions for Use

The rate of Tide Plant Guard is indicated for the control product spray mixtures listed below. Control product spray mixtures, their preparation and uses are to be derived from the individual labels for the control products.

When using spray volumes less than 93.54 L/ha, do not apply Tide Plant Guard at less than 469 mL/ha.

Mixing Instructions

- SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING
- Always add Tide Plant Guard adjuvant to the spray mix **last** and continue agitation, or follow specific tank-filling and mixing information provided on the herbicide label

Storage

- Do not store near heat or open flame; store in a dry location
- Storage above freezing is recommended; if product freezes, warm and agitate (recirculate) prior to using
- Store away from food or feed

Container Disposal

1. Triple- or pressure-rinse the empty container; add the rinsings to the spray mixture in the tank
 2. Make the empty, rinsed container unsuitable for further use
- Recyclable container – dispose of at a container collection site; do not reuse for any purpose
 - If there is no collection site in your area, dispose of the container in accordance with provincial requirements
 - For disposal of unused product or in case of a spill, contact the manufacturer or the provincial regulatory agency
